

KID'S TALENT DAY

Dear Children's Leader,

ICD Children's Ministry is proud to present our **Third Annual Talent Day!** It will take place on **April 28, 2012, at 9:00am, at our Noblesville Lakeview Drive Wesleyan Church, 730 Lakeview Drive.** Each church who pre-registers will receive a small gift for each child in their group. Pre-registrations will only be accepted until April 14. The child may choose three events from the categories listed below. Each child will be judged and critiqued by an expert in that category.

The comments will only help the child to build on their current skills and abilities. At the end of the day every child will be rewarded for their efforts with Gold (Superior), Silver (Excellent), or Bronze (Great).

When arriving at the event ...

On the morning of Talent Day each group needs to arrive at 9:00 am to register their children. Each leader or parent will receive a schedule for their group of kids. It is the adult's responsibility to make sure each child gets to their needed event on time. There will be a break at 11:00 for lunch to which concessions will be offered; all proceeds going to Kids' Camp. At the conclusion of the event, the children will gather together in the sanctuary for a time of recognition and celebration.

MUSICAL PIECES

If the child is doing a musical piece (singing *and/or* instrument) they must have their own pianist or CD if needed. A copy of the sheet music must be provided for the judge prior to singing. They will be judged on tonality, appearance, stage presence and memorization.

COOKING

The children will need to make their food prior to the event. They will also need to write the ingredients on an index card with their name. They will be judged on flavor, texture, presentation and difficulty.

HOT-SHOT/FREE-THROW

The children will be competing against each other in this event. The one who gets the most will win. However, we will have a seasoned player to help the children improve their skills.

ART

The children will need to submit their painting, drawing or sculpture when they sign in. These pieces will be displayed in a designated art room for all to view throughout the day. Along with the piece the child must submit a short essay stating their name, age and a short paragraph about their artwork. They will be judged according to their piece.

CREATIVE WRITING

These children will need to write a speech, poem or essay prior to the event. The child will be judged on content, structure and flow of the paper.

CREATIVE MOVEMENT

The children will need to create an appropriate dance which may include various styles for this section. They may use ribbons, flags or other dance oriented props. They must bring their own appropriate music in the form of a CD. They will perform their piece and will be judged on creativity, stage presence, enthusiasm and movement.
